The undergraduate Museum and Cultural Heritage Studies Certificate provides students with a broad background in museum and cultural heritage studies and prepares students for entry-level careers in museums, cultural heritage sites, and similar venues that promote public outreach and education, and provides a solid foundation for students who wish to pursue advanced studies in the fields of Museum or Cultural Heritage studies. Core courses introduce students to the history of museums, cultural heritage management, administration, curation, artifact handling, collections management, interpretation, exhibitions, ethics, and working with indigenous communities.
