Objectives:

LCHI200 is a student-centered, activities-driven class that verges on immersion. This means we will meet daily and conduct class mostly in Chinese. The goal of this class is to integrate the four

language skills of listening, speaking, reading and writing. By semester end, students will be able to: 1) read and understand simple texts, 2) understand detailed grammatical patterns, conversations on familiar topics, and comprehend a greater amount of relevant cultural information, 3) converse about course readings, facts, personal experience and opinions. Students will also give a presentation and do weekly one-on-one oral practice with a language partner. The chapter homework assignments will be all written in Chinese.

Course format:

This course is designed to assist students in increasing their vocabulary and grammar understanding as well as immerse students in Chinese daily life through the texts.

Objectives for the semester:

Listening: You will be exposed to an increasing amount of Chinese which will strengthen your listening skills. However, expect the instructor to use English to describe difficult grammar structures or cultural concepts. Your ability to understand Chinese spoken at a native pace should improve greatly.

Speaking: You will improve your ability to initiate or carry conversation in Chinese on a variety of topics. You will be encouraged to conduct classroom activities in the target language.

Reading: You will read material in both Chinese and English. You will also be exposed to Chinese internet sites, comics, menus, TV and movie programs. Some short stories will also help you understand the origins of certain idioms.

Writing: Students will be required to memorize and learn how to write Chinese characters. Homework, quizzes, and tests will all be conducted in Chinese.

Culture: We will learn about several aspects of the Chinese culture through various media including lectures, articles, books, movies, TV programs, internet sites, comics, etc.
