Students minoring in French, German or Spanish must complete 21 credits.

At least 15 credits must be upper division in the target language; a minimum grade of C is required for students adding the program after Fall 2000. **At least 3 of those 15 credits must be either a culture or a literature course, and at least 3 credits must be 400-level.** Select courses from the lists below. Courses taught in English (Lxxx250, LGEN 465A-D), Service Learning (Lxxx379/479), or "wild-card" (3**, 4**) transfer credits will not count towards the 15 upper-division credit requirement.

A maximum of 6 credits may be lower-division. Students *placing* directly into the upper division level or into Lxxx201 need to *replace* 3-6 lower division credits. One way is to take additional upper-division, target-language courses. Other options **require prior approval by the department chair**. See the Department for more information.

Transfer Credit: Students transferring credit from other universities (domestic or foreign) will be asked to provide detailed course descriptions/syllabi/tests/papers/etc. to the Department for review before the final degree/minor check is done (at the beginning of the graduation semester). Otherwise graduation may be delayed. Any exception to this policy must be petitioned and approved by the Department chair. In order to facilitate *RE*-evaluations being done in a timely fashion, it is strongly recommended that students *complete their study-abroad program one full academic year before graduation*.
